Project Overview

MFB are a Global law firm specializing in international shipping legislation, advise and insurance.

Based in Fishmonger Hall with stunning views of the Thames MFB were looking to renovate their beautiful grade 2 listed offices in both terms of design and technical enhancements.

Their previous technology had organically evolved and was limited to table mounted USB peripherals with only few dedicated meeting spaces.

The renovation allowed for 4x dedicated video conferencing/meeting spaces with a divisible room which could be joined to for large events and conferences.

With Fishmonger Hall benefitting from listed status the technology chosen had to confirm to local regulations with limited changed to both the internal and external structure of the building.

Key Points

- International Shipping Law Firm
- Listed building – minimal fixings to the walls.
- No formal process for video calls.
- Divisible space to be used as individual meeting rooms, and event/conference space when joined together.
- Renovation of existing offices with short build time to avoid operational disruption.

Full AV design and build including solution creation, installation, training and ongoing support to suit listed building status.

Solution Provided

BMT designed a solution that conformed the client requirements including the listed status, condensed timescales, Teams based solution, divisible space and ongoing support/training. This was achieved through:

- Microsoft Teams Room environments with consistent and simplified end user device configuration.
- Yealink S90 solution in the divisible room with multiple cameras allowing both the main boardroom and conference space to be captured in the correct format.
- Drop down electronic projector screen to facilitate the conference space presentations when the room is combined mode.
- Yealink Meetboard mobile trolley solution in rooms that could not be fitted due to listed status. Touch screen enabled with TC8 control panels.
- Yealink A30 conference bar for the only fitted meeting room on the 1st floor.
- Nureva HDL audio solution for the divisible room with ceiling mounted microphones capturing audio in the whole room.
- 4k Ultra HD LG screens for the fitted spaces including the meeting room and boardroom.

The Yealink multicamera S90 solution when combined the Nureva's HDL technology allowed for a very seamless divisible/combined space. One simple switch combined the room, with camera selection allowing instantaneous switching of cameras views as required.

The Teams control panels in each room achieved the consistent and simple to use interfaces desired by the end users. Training and ongoing support has ensured a smooth and efficient AV solution.
